

#### **SECTION 1:**

#### **ONSET OF PUBERTY**



When you were a baby, everything in this world was a new experience. You explored it with your senses, helping you to learn about your new surroundings. By toddlerhood, you may have started asking lots of questions about the world and its Creator.

"Why is the sky blue?"
"Why can't I see Allah ?"
"How was I made?"

As you entered school age, you yearned to connect with Your Creator. It is for this reason that at age seven, the Prophet (ﷺ) commanded your parents to teach you to pray:

By school-age, you may have developed a connection with your fitra (awareness of God) in that He is your Creator and the Creator of all that exists. By this age, you may also became well aware of the physical differences between males and females.

"Females can carry babies and feed them, but males can't".

"Males can grow facial hair, but females can't".

"Males and females have different privacy parts".

In this stage, your parents may have taught you about respect and privacy for your body and that of others as well as seek permission before entering your parent's room at three times of the day:

Believers! At three times let those whom your right hands possess and those of your children who have not yet reached puberty let them ask permission before entering your quarters: before the Morning Prayer and when you take off your clothes at noon, and after the Night Prayer. These are the three times of privacy for you. If they come to you at other times then there is no sin for them nor for you, for you have to visit one another frequently.

Thus, does Allah clearly explain His directives to you.

Allah is All-Knowing, All-Wise. (Surat An-Noor 24:58)

As you grow older, your maturity, and knowledge of the world with the help of your parents will lead to several more rulings, such as the following:

#### 1. Perform the five daily salah صلاة.

The Prophet (ﷺ) said,
"...And invoke them to do it [salah] by the age of ten...".
(Abu Dawud)

#### 2. Seeking permission before entering someone else's private room.

And when your children attain puberty let them ask leave to come to you like their elders used to ask leave.

Thus Allah makes clear His Ayat

[Commandments and legal obligations] for you.

And Allah is All-Knowing, All-Wise.

(Surat An-Noor 24:59)

#### 3. Sleep in your own space.

#### 4. And finally, seek knowledge.

Read in the name of your Lord Who created.

He created man from a clot.

Read and your Lord is the Most Honorable.

Who taught by the pen. Taught man what he knew not.

(Surat Al 'Alaq 96:1-5)

These physical, mental and spiritual changes from birth to now serve as a stepping stone for your greatest change of all: puberty.

Puberty, also known as Al Hulum الخُلم, is a special time in your life when your body and mind change from a child into a mature adult. It takes several years and can feel out of control, scary, and exciting. Everyone goes through it but not always at the same time or in exactly the same way.

This stage is also extremely important for you as a Muslim because it is when you become accountable for everything you do in this life.

#### When Does Puberty Begin?

Puberty starts at different ages depending on your gender, genetics, diet and environment. On average, it begins between the ages of:

- 9 14 for girls, and
- 12 15 for boys.1

A person going through puberty is called an adolescent. Adolescence is the period following the onset of puberty when a young person develops from a child into an adult.

#### **FUN FACT:**

#### WHEN PUBERTY IS TOO EARLY OR TOO LATE

If puberty begins earlier than the average age range, it is called **Precocious Puberty**. For girls, that is before age eight, and for boys that is before age nine.<sup>2</sup>

If puberty begins later than the average age range, it is called **Delayed Puberty**. For girls, that is after age 13, and for boys it is after age 14.<sup>3</sup>


In both cases, you should see a doctor to be evaluated for any underlying health concerns.

#### **How Does Puberty Start?**


Puberty begins when an area in your brain sends a message to your reproductive organs. This message tells them to release the hormones that will transform your body from a child into an adult.

Let us take a closer look.


1. An area in your brain, called the Hypothalamus, releases the hormone GnRH (Gonadotropin-Releasing Hormone).




2. GnRH travels to another part of your brain called the Pituitary Gland. It tells the pituitary gland to release two hormones: LH (Luteinizing Hormone) and FSH (Follicle-Stimulating Hormone).



3. LH and FSH enter your bloodstream and travel to your gonads. Gonads are your reproductive organs. LH and FSH tell them to release hormones that will begin the physical and mental changes of puberty.



Here is a summary of how puberty starts:





#### A. FROM BOYS TO MEN:

When LH and FSH travel to the male reproductive system, they go directly to the male gonads, called testicles. Testicles are two oval-shaped organs outside of the male.

When the testicles receive the message to begin puberty, they do two things:

- 1. They make testosterone. Testosterone is a hormone that will make males develop facial and body hair, a deeper voice, bigger muscles and more.
- 2. They make sperm. Sperm enables males to have children one day. This is known as Fertility.







#### **B. FROM GIRLS TO WOMEN**

When LH and FSH travel to the female reproductive system, they go directly to the female gonads, called Ovaries. They are two-oval shaped organs inside the pelvis.

When the ovaries receive the message to begin puberty, they do two things:

- 1. They make estrogen. Estrogen is a hormone that will cause the development of breasts, wider hips, increased height and more.
- 2. They release eggs. Eggs have been inside the ovaries since birth. They are released during puberty to make females fertile through menstruation.





In summary, puberty begins when new chemicals are released into your body that transform you physically, mentally and spiritually into an adult.

The following sections will discuss each of these three transformations.

# SECTION 2: PHYSICAL CHANGES

#### **How Does My Body Change During Puberty?**

Once hormones have been released, your body is now ready to go through the changes of puberty.

The physical changes are of the two following types:

- A. Secondary sex characteristics, and
- B. Fertility.

#### A. SECONDARY SEX CHARACTERISTICS

Secondary Sex Characteristics are what transform a boy to look like a man and a girl to look like a woman. These changes follow a specific order called the Tanner Stages.

Tanner Stages give you an idea of when and what physical changes you will go through during puberty. While these changes follow a specific order, it is important to remember that everyone begins and moves through the stages at their own pace.

The following chart describes the physical changes both males and females go through within each Tanner Stage:<sup>4</sup>

## \*FOR MALES: Why Is My Voice Squeaking So Much?!?


While girls develop a slightly deeper voice, it is boys who go through a more dramatic vocal change during puberty.

The transition of a higher pitched voice to a deeper voice does not occur overnight. It takes time and undergoes voice variations such as cracks, squeaks and breaks, before it permanently changes.

#### **How Does My Voice Change?**

Testosterone travels to the voice box, or larynx, causing it to grow. The larynx also contains vocal cords. Testosterone will thicken these cords, creating a deeper sound when air passes through them as you talk.

While it may feel embarrassing that your voice keeps cracking, it is completely normal and only temporary. It takes several months for this growth to be complete.




#### Is This Why My Neck Has a Bump?

When the larynx grows bigger, it tilts to a different angle, causing part of it to stick out inside your neck. In medical terms, it is called the Cricothyroid, but it is commonly called the Adam's Apple (from a Christian reference of Prophet Adam eating an apple from the forbidden tree).

These secondary sex characteristics differ in type and in time frame between the two genders, but the cause is the same: they occur due to an increase in hormones.

This hormonal surge will also cause additional changes, such as acne, body odor and nocturnal emissions (to be discussed in chapter 3, Hygiene).

#### **B. FERTILITY**



Fertility means being able to have a baby. A baby is made when sperm (from a male) combines with an egg (from a female) inside the female body during Sexual Intercourse.

#### How Does a Boy Know He Is Fertile?

A male is fertile when sperm is produced in his testicles. A physical sign of male fertility is the release of a white fluid called Semen from the penis during moments of sexual excitement.

#### How Does a Girl Know She Is Fertile?

A female is fertile when an egg from her ovary is released each month. A physical sign of female fertility is when she starts having a period, or Menstruation.

Fertility is a major aspect of becoming an adult. When reaching this physical milestone, you now become intellectually and spiritually responsible for learning about reproduction.
