FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 132 cm / 52"

Width at widest point: 6.35 cm / 2 ½" Width at narrowest point: 2.5 cm / 1"

YARN

BC Garn Sarah Tweed (DK; 50% silk, 40% Wool, 10% bourette silk nups; 176 m / 192 yds per 50g) Shade: st27, 1 skein.

NEEDLES AND NOTIONS

3.5mm / US 4 knitting needles & tapestry needle.

GAUGE

24 sts & 38 rows = 10 cm / 4" in moss stitch (US: seed st)

ABBREVATIONS

Dec: decrease

K: knit

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together

P: purl

P2tog: purl 2 stitches together

St(s): stitch(es)

PATTERN

Cast on 17 sts.

Row 1: [K1, P1] to end.

Row 1 sets moss st pattern.

Work in moss st until piece measures 48 cm / 19".

Commence shaping as follows:

Next row (Dec): [K1, p1] 3 times, k1, p2tog, k2tog,

[p1, k1] 3 times. 15 sts Work 17 rows in moss st.

Next row (Dec): [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2tog, k2tog,

[p1, k1] 3 times. 13 sts Work 17 rows in moss st.

Next row (Dec): [K1, p1] twice, k1, p2tog, k2tog,

[p1, k1] twice. 11 sts

Work 17 rows in moss st.

Next row: [K1, p1] to last st, k1.

Next row: [P1, k1] to last st, p1.

Last 2 rows set 1x1 rib.

Work in rib as set for 71 cm / 28".

Cast off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and gently steam block.
