




# **2 NOTE**

- **a.** To use this kit you must have the Forward Track Mount Board Kit Installed. Review those instructions for installation.
- b. Caution: The Bow Mount Plate is intended for Bow Mount Motors and Accessory mounting. IT IS NOT DESIGNED TO BE A STANDING PLATFORM!




### **3** ASSEMBLY

- **a.** EVA installation (EVA padding installation is optional and you may want to leave this off if you are mounting items to the top)
  - Make sure that Bow Mount Plate is clean from any dirt/ contaminants
  - Unpack and lay out all of the EVA parts per the drawing here. Make sure that you have a good fit an alignment between all of the pads. (Figure Below)




- Select one of the foam pads and peel back a small section of the backing. Align the pad back on the board and press down on the area where you removed the backing strip. Press down and make sure that it is appropriately aligned.
- Remove the remaining backing paper and stick the pad down by applying pressure from the center, outward, to prevent bubbles from collecting.
- If you cannot get any small bubbles out, poke the bubble with a sharp blade to allow for the air to escape while pressing the bubble flat.
- **b.** Assemble the bow mount plate to the rails as shown here (Figure Below)




# **4 BOAT INSTALLATION**


**a.** Insert the rear track slugs into the Forward Track Mounts and slide forward. (Figure Below)



**b.** Tighten down the knobs. (Figure Below)



**c.** Feed the webbing strap through the slot located at the front of the Bow Mount Plate and the D-ring located on the bow of the NS130. Tighten down the strap to secure the front of the Bow Mount Plate. (Figure Below)



## **5 TROLLING MOTOR INSTALLATION**

- **a.** Follow the instructions included with your bow mounted trolling motor for installation to the plate. All trolling motors are different, so please note that you may need to provide your own hardware for mounting.
- b. It is recommended that you remove one of the EVA pads to install your trolling motor flush onto the Bow Mount Plate. (Figure Below)
