


Switches

Wired Mode

Connect the keyboard to your device via an USB cable (Type-C)

- Plug & play method
- Keyboard's internal battery will be charged while in wired mode
- FN + 5 for wired mode





Bluetooth Connection Mode

Keyboard consist of 3 bluetooth profile, can connect up to 3 separate devices.

- Hold FN + 1 for profile 1
- Hold FN + 2 for profile 2
- Hold FN + 3 for profile 3
- 1 / 2 / 3 key flashes quickly Connecting to device
- 1 / 2 / 3 key flashes slowly Searching for bluetooth connectivity
- 1 / 2 / 3 key stop flashing Keyboard is successfully connected

2.4g Wireless Connection Mode

Hassle free plug & play wireless method

- Hold FN + 4 for 2.4g USB wireless connection mode
- Plug in the wireless USB dongle to your device

Notes: Change the keyboard's mode to wireless connection mode before inserting the wireless USB dongle

• FN+WIN	<lock key="" window=""></lock>	• FN+F7	<pause></pause>
• FN+F1	<play></play>	• FN+F8	<next></next>
• FN+F2	<lower volume=""></lower>	• FN+F9	<mail></mail>
• FN+F3	<increase volume=""></increase>	• FN+F10	<home></home>
• FN+F4	<mute></mute>	• FN+F11	<calculator></calculator>
• FN+F5	<stop></stop>	• FN+F12	<search></search>
• FN+F6	<previous></previous>		

Backlit Control

• FN+INS	Flash Mode 1	FN+Backspace	On/Off Backlit
• FN+Home	Flash Mode 2	• FN+\	Change Color
• FN+PGUP	Flash Mode 3	• FN+Up	Increase Brightness
• FN+DEL	Flash Mode 4	• FN+Down	Decrease Brightness
• FN+END	Flash Mode 5	• FN+Left	Decrease Backlit Speed
• FN+PGDN	Flash Mode 6	• FN+Right	Increase Backlit Speed

System Requirement

Wired

- Computer with available USB port
- PC: Windows 7 or Later
- Mac: macOS X 10.6 Snow Leopard or Later

Notes:

- It is recommended to charge the keyboard through computer's USB port (Lower voltage)
- Charging time varies on computer's USB port voltage (2 4 hours until fully charged)
- FN key will lit if the keyboard is charging
