# JACKET • SETASURI Design 7 - Lookbook 15 

Size 36/38 (40/42, 44/46, 48/50)
Instructions are given for first size. Figures in parenthesis refer to larger sizes. When only one figure is given, it applies to all sizes.

Materials: $175(\mathbf{1 7 5}, \mathbf{2 0 0}, \mathbf{2 2 5}) \mathbf{g}$ each of Lana Grossa Setasuri (69\% Suri alpaca, 31\% silk; $212 \mathrm{~m} / 25 \mathrm{~g}$ ) in Cream (col 2) and Peach (col 3). Size 4.5 mm needles.

Note: Work with 1 strand of each color held tog throughout = 2 strands held tog.

Brioche rib over an odd number of sts: Row 1 (RS): * K1, yosl1 (make a yo, then sl next st pwise); rep from *, end k1. Row 2 (WS): * Yosl1, ktog slipped st with its yo; rep from *, end yosl1. Row 3 (RS): * Ktog slipped st with its yo; yosl1; rep from *, end ktog slipped st with its yo. Work rows $1-3$ once, then rep rows 2 and 3 .

Brioche rib over an even number of sts: Row 1 (RS): * K1, yosl1 (make a yo, then sl next st pwise); rep from *. Row 2 (WS): * Ktog slipped st with its yo, yosl1; rep from *. Work rows 1 - 2 once, then rep row 2.

Note: In brioche rib, 1 stitch and 1 yo are treated as 1 stitch.
Slip st rib: Row 1 (RS): * K1, p1; rep from *, end k1. All foll rows: Knit all knit sts, sl all purl sts pwise wyif.

Full-fashion dbl decrease: At beg of WS row, 7 sts in brioche rib, sk2p; at end of WS row, work to last 10 sts, k3tog, 7 sts in brioche rib.

Full-fashion dbl increase [front edge shaping]: On RS row: 7 sts in brioche rib, (k1, yo, k1) in next st; at end of RS row, work to last 8 sts, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, 7 sts in brioche rib. On foll WS row, knit into yos.

Full-fashion dbl increase [sleeve shaping]: On RS row: 3 sts in brioche rib, (k1, yo, k1) in next st; at end of RS row, work to last 4 sts, (k1, yo, k1) in next st, 3 sts in brioche rib. On foll WS row, knit into yos.

Gauge: 17 sts and 40 rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ in brioche rib with size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.

Back: With size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on $89(95,101,107)$ sts. Next row (RS): Work slip st rib over first 3 sts, work brioche rib to last 3 sts, work slip st rib over last 3 sts. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 44 (42 40, 38) cm from cast-on, ending with a RS row. Shape raglan: Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each end of 5th row, then every 6th row 4 times, then every 8th row 8 ( 9 , $10,11)$ times and when piece meas $25(27,29,31) \mathrm{cm}$ from beg of raglan shaping, bind off rem $33(35,37,39)$ sts.

Left front: With size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on $53(57,61,65)$ sts. Next row $(R S)$ : Work slip st rib over first 3 sts, work brioche rib to last 6 sts, work slip st rib over last 6 sts. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 38 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Working full-fashion dbl inc, inc 2 sts at end of next RS row $=55(59,63,67)$ sts. Cont in patt as established until same length as back to raglan. Shape raglan at right edge same as for back $=27$ (29, 31, 33) sts rem for neckband. Cont in patt across neckband sts for $18(19,20,21) \mathrm{cm}$. Bind off all sts.

Right front: Work same as left front, reversing all shaping and patt placement.

Sleeves: With size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on $49(51,53,55)$ sts. Next row $(R S)$ : Work slip st rib over first 3 sts, work brioche rib to last 3 sts, work slip st rib over last 3 sts. Work in patt as set by last row until piece meas 14 $(13,12,11) \mathrm{cm}$ from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Shape sleeve: Work even for 14 rows, ending with a WS row. Working full-fashion dbl inc, inc 2 sts at each end of next RS row, then every 16th row $4(5,6,7)$ times $=69(75,81,87)$ sts. Work increased sts into patt. Work even until piece meas 45 $(44,43,42) \mathrm{cm}$ from cast-on, ending with a RS row. Shape sleeve cap: Working full-fashion dbl dec, dec 2 sts at each end of 7th row, then every 8th row $11(12,13,14)$ times and when piece meas $24(26,28,30) \mathrm{cm}$ from beg of cap shaping, bind off rem $21(23,25,27)$ sts.

Pockets: Make 2. With size 4.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog cast on $27(29,31,33)$ sts. Work in brioche rib for 14 $(15,16,17) \mathrm{cm}$. Bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew pockets to fronts, approx. 5 cm up from bottom edge and 10 cm in from front edge. Sew raglan seams. Sew bound-off edges of neckbands tog, then sew neckband to back neck and top of sleeves. Sew side and sleeve seams.

## Gauge Swatch

## Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. $12 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12 \mathrm{~cm}$. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm . If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
