# Design 27 – Lookbook 15



Size approx. 40 x 180 cm

Materials: 50 g each of Lana Grossa Setasuri (69% Suri alpaca, 31% silk; 212 m/25 g) in White (col 1) and Light Grey (col 19) and 75 g in Turquoise (col 28). Size 5.5 mm needles.

**Note**: Work with 2 strands held tog as given in instructions.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

**Checkerboard patt**: Worked over 62 sts and 54 rows. <u>Row 1 (RS)</u>: With 2 strands Turquoise held tog, k16; with 1 strand Turquoise and 1 strand White held tog, k15; with 1 strand Turquoise and 1 strand Light Grey held tog, k15; with 2 strands Turquoise held tog, k16. Work each block of color with separate ball of yarn. Twist yarns around each other at each color change to prevent holes. <u>Rows 2 – 18</u>: Work in St st and colors as established. <u>Row 19 (RS)</u>: With 1 strand White and 1 strand Turquoise held tog, k16; with 2 strands

White held tog, k15; with 1 strand Light Grey and 1 strand White held tog, k15; with 1 strand White and 1 strand Turquoise held tog, k15. Rows 20 – 36: Work in St st and colors as established. Row 37 (RS): With 1 strand Light Grey and 1 strand Turquoise held tog, k16; with 1 strand White and 1 strand Light Grey held tog, k15; with 2 strands Light Grey held tog, k15; with 1 strand Light Grey and 1 strand Turquoise held tog, k16: Rows 38 – 54: Work in St st and colors as established. Work rows 1 – 54 a total of 6 times, then work rows 1 – 17 once more.

**Gauge**: 15 sts and 19 rows =  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm}$  in St st with size 5.5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.

**Scarf**: With size 5.5 mm needles and 2 strands Turquoise held tog firmly cast on 62 sts. Work checkerboard patt for 341 rows and piece meas approx. 180 cm from cast-on. Using 2 strands Turquoise held tog, firmly bind off all sts.

#### **Checkerboard pattern**



## Gauge Swatch

#### Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.

**beg** = begin(ning)  $\cdot$  **ch** = chain  $\cdot$  **cont** = continue  $\cdot$  **dec** = decreas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **inc** = increas(e)(ing)  $\cdot$  **k** = knit  $\cdot$  **kwise** = as if to knit **meas** = measures  $\cdot$  **M1L** = lift strand between sts from front to back and knit this strand through the back loop  $\cdot$  **M1R** = lift strand between sts from the back and knit this strand through the front loop  $\cdot$  **patt** = pattern  $\cdot$  **pm** = place marker  $\cdot$  **p** = purl **pwise** = as if to purl  $\cdot$  **rem** = remain(ing)  $\cdot$  **rep** = repeat(s)  $\cdot$  **rev St st** = reverse stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **rnd(s)** = round(s)  $\cdot$  **RS** = right side  $\cdot$  **sc** = single crochet  $\cdot$  **skp** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 1 stitch, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **sk2p** = slip 1 stitch as if to knit, knit 2 together, pass slipped stitch over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s2kp** = slip 2 stitches as if to knit, k 1 stitch, pass slipped stitches over knitted stitch  $\cdot$  **s1** = slip  $\cdot$  **st(s)** = stitch(es)  $\cdot$  **St st** = stockinette stitch  $\cdot$  **tbl** = through the back loop  $\cdot$  **tog** = together  $\cdot$  **wyib** = with yarn in back of work  $\cdot$  **wyif** = with yarn in front of work  $\cdot$  **WS** = wrong side  $\cdot$  **yo(s)** = yarn over(s)
