

Design 49 – Journal 66

SCARF SETASURI

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Size 47 x 216 cm

Materials: 50 g each of Lana Grossa Setasuri (69% Suri alpaca, 31% silk; 212 m/25 g) in White (col 1), Salmon (col 22), Lobster (col 23) and Pink (col 8). Size 5 mm needles.

Note: Work with 2 strands of yarn held tog as given in instructions.

Rib patt: K1, p1.

St st: K on RS, p on WS.

Two-stitch selvage: On RS row, sl 1 pwise wyib, k1, patt to last 2 sts, k1, sl 1 pwise wyib. On WS row, p1, sl 1 pwise wyif, patt to last 2 sts, sl 1 pwise wyif, p1.

Gauge: 15 sts and 20 rows = 10×10 cm in St st with size 5 mm needles and 2 strands held tog.

Scarf: With 2 strands Pink held tog cast on 71 sts. Next row (WS): Two-st selvage, * k1, p1; rep from * to last 3 sts, k1, two-stitch selvage. Work in rib patt as set by last row until piece meas 5 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Next row (RS): Two-st selvage, work next 5 sts in rib patt as established, work in St st to last 7 sts, work next 5 sts in rib patt as established, two-stitch selvage. Cont in patt as set by last row until piece meas 45 cm from cast-on, ending with a WS row. Drop 1 strand Pink, join 1 strand White and cont in patt as established for 12 cm, ending with a WS row. Drop Pink, join 2nd strand White and cont in patt as established for 45 cm, ending with a WS row. Drop 1 strand White, join 1 strand Salmon and cont in patt as established for 12 cm, ending with a WS row. Drop White, join 2nd strand Salmon and cont in patt as established for 45 cm, ending with a WS row. Drop 1 strand Salmon, join 1 strand Lobster and cont in patt as established for 12 cm, ending with a WS row. Drop Salmon, join 2nd strand Lobster and cont in patt as established for 45 cm, ending with a WS row. Maintaining two-stitch selvage, work in rib patt same as at beg of work for 5 cm. Loosely bind off all sts.

Finishing: Pin piece to measurements and block.




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Gauge Swatch

Before you begin ...

...make a gauge swatch. Use the recommended needles, yarns and pattern stitch for your gauge swatch. It should measure approx. 12 cm x 12 cm. Cast-on and bind-off rows, as well as selvage stitches should not be included in the measurement. Pin your swatch and block it as you would the finished pieces of the garment. Count stitches and rows over 10 cm. If your gauge swatch is too small, switch to larger needles. If your gauge swatch is too big, switch to smaller needles.
