A single stroller can be hard enough to haul in and out of cars and even through airports and train stations, but a double stroller can be double the trouble. That's why we were so impressed with the performance of the Jeep Destination Ultralight. We really liked how this stroller maneuvered, especially over stairs and uneven surfaces — it performs well on tight turns, too. The fact that it went up the stairs so easily was one of the best features about this stroller. The brake is easy to engage and release and folding/unfolding is also a cinch, which should give parents peace of mind when traveling with their little ones.

This Jeep double stroller has seats that can recline independently, along with adjustable calf rests. The canopy extends and offers UPF protection, which is a nice feature. There's a peek-a-boo window, though it would be preferable to have vented mesh instead of plastic. In terms of ease of assembly, we had the Jeep out of the box and ready to go in just four minutes; it comes already assembled on the frame — we just had to add the wheels and snap the arm bars and were literally good to go.
