Cons

If you're looking for a classic nursery rocker with a sustainable twist, the Delta Children Ella Rocker is for you. You'd never guess that this beautiful chair is made from 30% polyester yarn derived from recycled post-consumer plastic bottles, or that its fabric repels water and resists stains. We love that it feels soft and comfortable and its metal and wood base gives it a modern flair.

Assembling this chair can be done by one person, but plan that it will take around 40 minutes to do so. You should also keep in mind that it comes in a large, wide box, so make sure you have enough space to store it before you put it together.

One of our editors who tested this rocker with her baby deemed it Pinterest-worthy and says it is "perfect" for her posture. She likes that there's enough room to cross her legs while sitting and feels like she's being cradled by its large, cushioned seat. It also comes with a lumbar pillow to support your lower back, but we like that it can be removed if needed. However, it's not likely that you'll truly rest in this rocker since its armrests are thin and it doesn't recline or come with an ottoman.

After spending many hours cuddled up in this glider, we can confidently say that sitting in it with your baby is something you will look forward to doing. Its seat cushion and armrests are thickly padded, which explains why our muscles never feel stiff or tight after sitting in it for an extended period of time. We especially love that it's available in a soft, velvet fabric and that the seat is wide enough to get comfy while cradling your baby in either arm.



This glider earned a spot on our list due to how easily and smoothly it reclines. While most recliners tilt back to one position, this one allows you to recline to any position you find comfortable and does so with the touch of a button (and without a sound). It also has a convenient USB port to charge your device and is upholstered in stain-resistant, water-repellent fabric.

Assembling this glider was more difficult than we expected. While there are only two pieces to put together, we struggled to fully align the backrest with the seat, even after multiple attempts. Once we finally got it right, we were pleased to see it offers great stability. Overall, we think it has great value, especially because the recline setting is customizable to any person who uses it.
