

Why We Love It

The Delta Children Essex 4-in-1 Convertible Crib is a 2023 winner from both the What to Expect Sleep Awards and the Mom Must-Have Awards for a reason. With its stylish midcentury modern look (there are three color options, each with contrasting angled legs) this crib looks great in any nursery. But it's also amazingly functional: It has three adjustable mattress heights and four different configurations to last years and years.

When your baby outgrows crib mode, you can remove one side and add a <u>toddler guardrail</u> (which is sold separately) to transform the crib into a toddler bed. After that, the guardrail can come off to create a space-saving daybed you can use for your child's naps or a comfortable sofa. Considering the crib is only \$200 — making it one of the more affordable convertible options on the market — this is an amazing value.

Parents say this crib feels sturdy and well-made, and also appreciate how easy it is to assemble and switch between heights. Also good: You also have the option to purchase the <u>crib and mattress together</u> as a bundle, which many families appreciate. And at 34 inches high, this is relatively low for a convertible crib and a great option for shorter parents.
