# **USES**

- > Can be Brush, Roller or Spray applied.
- > To be used on plastered and embossed wall coverings, wallboards, concrete, cement rendering, brickwork and blockwork.
- > FOR INTERIOR USE ONLY.
- > Not suitable for areas subjected to heavy condensation.
- > Do not apply when the air or substrate temperatures are likely to fall below 8°C or when the relative humidity is above 80% during application or the drying period.

#### COLOUR RANGE

> White or Magnolia. When using more than one tin of colour in the same room intermix before use.

#### FINISH

> Matt.

#### **PACK SIZE**

> Available in 5 and 15 Litre containers.

# SPREADING RATE

> Up to 13 square metres/litre per coat depending on the nature and porosity of the surface being painted.

# **DRYING TIME**

- > Under normal drying, touch dry in 2 hours, recoatable after 4 hours.
- > Allow for adequate ventilation during the drying period.

#### SHELF LIFE

> Up to 12 months if stored correctly in an unopened container.



#### **PREPARATION**

- > All surfaces must be painted should be clean, dry and free from loose and flaking material.
- > Prime bare surfaces with the appropriate Britannia Primer.
- > Rub down previously gloss painted surfaces with fine waterproof abrasive paper and rinse thoroughly.
- > Avoid the inhalation of dust.
- > Wear a suitable face mask if dry sanding.
- > Special precautions should be taken during surface preparation of pre-1960's paint surfaces over wood and metal as they may contain harmful lead.

## APPLICATION

- > STIR WELL BFORE USE.
- > Easy to apply by brush or roller.
- > Also suitable for application by spray (see below).
- > If more than one can of colour is to be used in the same area, intermix before use.
- > Ensure good ventilation during application and drying.
- > Do not apply in temperatures below 10°C or in damp conditions.

## **SPRAY & THINNING APPLICATION**

> Thinning: sealing new or bare surfaces: up to 1.5 part clean water to 10 parts paint @ 2500 PSI / 172 bar with a 517 tip.

#### AIRLESS SPRAY:

- > Un-thinned: Spray @ 3000 PSI / 207 bar with 517 tip.
- > Thinned: 1 part clean water to 10 parts paint spray @ 2500 PSI /172 bar with 517 tip.

#### CLEANING

- > Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning.
- > Replace lid firmly. Clean equipment immediately after use with warm soapy water and rinse thoroughly.
- > Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste coatings.
- > Do not empty product into drains or watercourses.

#### **PRECAUTIONS**

- > Keep out of reach of children.
- > In case of contact with eyes wash immediately with plenty of water.
- > Remove splashes from skin with soap and water or a recognised hand cleaner.
- > Protect from freezing.
- > Do not apply paint if there is a risk of heavy rain or frost.
- > Do not use near fishponds.
