

How to put on the face mask -

- Clean your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer before touching the mask.
- Remove mask from package, take out the mask, hold by the two ends/ ear loops with the nose bridge at the top - white side should be facing towards the inside to touch the face, blue side should be facing to the outside.
- Cover the nose, mouth and jaw with the mask and loop the ear loops over each ear.
- 4. Adjust the position of the mask, mould or pinch the stiff edge over the bridge of the nose for a comfortable fit.
- The mask should cover the nose, mouth and chin at all times during wearing.
- 6. At no time should the mask hang around the neck of the wearer.

Warnings & cautions

- Please read the instructions on how to put on the face mask and how to remove the face mask, carefully before use.
- This product is single use, it should not be re-used.
- In case of liquid splashing, mask damage, moisture and/ or significant increase in respiratory resistance during wear please remove and replace immediately.

How to remove the face mask -

- Clean your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer before touching the mask.
- 2. Avoid touching the main part of the mask as this is contaminated, only touch the ear loops.
- 3. Hold both of the ear loops and gently lift and remove the mask.
- Dispose of the mask according to the requirements of the hospital or environmental protection department.
- 5. Clean your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer.

Storage method:

This product should be stored in a cool, dry, corrosive gas free, well ventilated and clean environment.
