- XI. 1984 Increase in mill rate
- XII. 1985 Increase in mill rate
- XIII. 1987 Special Assessment for capital improvements
- XIV. 1993 Increase in mill rate
- XV. 2006 Increase in mill rate and Special Assessment for pool and clubhouse renovation, gate study and road repairs
- XVI. 2008 Special Assessment for pool and clubhouse renovation
- XVII. 2011 Collection of delinquent charges and lien placement
- XVIII. 2017 Special Assessment for Kennilworth Enhancement Project and update of Extraordinary Road Use Charge

Additional By-law amendments made at annual meetings and not numbered:

6/13/1982 Interest rate for past due annual dues and assessments increase to 19% per annum

5/30/1984 Officers indemnification

5/18/1985 Board of Directors increase from 5 to 7 members

4/14/1993 Eliminates Nominating Committee. Members must nominate themselves for Board positions. Change in Certificate of Incorporation regarding number of Directors, date of Annual meeting and PO box mailing address
