

KENNILWORTH POOL RULES:

This pool is only open to Kennilworth members and their guests during pool hours. No one will be allowed in the swimming area unless the pool is officially open and a lifeguard is on duty. Entering the pool area when it is not open for public use can lead to loss of pool privilege or prosecution or both.

All members and guests must show ID and sign in with the lifeguard.

Kennilworth homeowners with pool privileges are required to show photographic proof of current residency, Kennilworth card valid driver's license or similar valid identification. Access will be denied if acceptable photographic proof is not displayed to the lifeguard. Access will be denied to any member whose assessments are not paid in full as determined by the Treasurer of the Board. In the case of any home owned by multiple individuals or an entity or entities that is/are not a natural person(s), to avoid an overburdening of the pool, only the individuals in actual residency at such Kennilworth home will be permitted use of the pool and clubhouse facilities (subject to the rule permitting guests).

Maximum number of guests is four (4) per household. The homeowner must accompany guests at all times and is responsible for such guests. Any guests over 4, will be charged \$25 each additional guest, maximum for guests is 8.

An adult must accompany and supervise all children under the age of 14 at all times. No person under the age of 21 is permitted in the clubhouse area, beach, dock or parking lot after dark, unless accompanied by an adult resident in good standing over the age of 21.

Lifeguard on duty has the discretion to request adult supervision for children should there be a safety concern. Lifeguard on duty may eject from the pool area members and guests for improper behavior and refusal to obey the rules and instructions.

Prior written permission of the Association is required for any large private parties at the Pool and Clubhouse and in all cases, such parties are restricted to dates and times where the facility is not ordinarily in peak use by members of the Association. Any guests over 4, will be charged \$25 each additional guest, maximum for guests is 8.

SAFETY FIRST!! No running is permitted on the deck or dock. Swimming is not permitted in the diving area. Please see diving rules below.

Please be considerate of others - Radios are to be played at a moderate level. Please leave a path for people to walk by along the perimeter of the pool.

Food and glass bottles are not allowed in the pool area. Food and drink must be confined to the beach and patio areas and prompt clean up is required.

Dogs and other pets are not permitted in the pool, beach or recreational area. As a reminder, all dogs are to be on a leash when walked in Kennilworth. The leash law is in effect in Kennilworth.

Please shower before using the pool. Infants are not permitted in the pool unless in approved swim diapers which comply with applicable health codes. All diapers and sanitary napkins must be disposed of in the garbage and under no circumstances should these be flushed down the bathroom toilet.

No swimming is allowed in the Long Island Sound.

Diving rules

- Dangerous practices are prohibited. Diving in shallow areas, backward entry dives, somersaults, cannon balls, or any other unsafe activities are not permitted.
- Divers must be able to swim to the ladder unassisted and may be asked to demonstrate their swimming ability by swimming one pool length before being allowed to use the deep end diving area.
- No diving off the side of the pool or the sides of the diving board.
- Children are not permitted to jump off the board onto other patrons or staff.
- No sitting on the diving board.
- Swimming aids like floaters, life jackets, water wings, goggles masks or fins may not be worn while using the diving board.
- Only one diver on the board at a time.
- One bounce per dive.
- Diver must wait until the preceding diver has surfaced and reached the ladder or edge of the pool.
- Do not swim toward or under the board at any time.
- Do not hang on the board.
- Swimming across the diving area is not allowed unless the diving boards are closed by staff.
- Staff reserves the right to stop any patron from performing any dive that might appear to be dangerous.
- Practice safe diving: "Look before you leap!"

The Board reserves the right to amend, modify and supplement the aforesaid Pool Rules at any time.
