

DECLARATION TO THE PEOPLE AND THE CONSTITUTION

I, _____, was served with this Declaration To The People And The Constitution on _____, that I am an "elected" public servant to the people of the United States of America, and of the State of Michigan, and having sworn an oath to uphold the Michigan Constitution and the United States Constitution, I do hereby declare that I will cease and desist from any and all activities that are in contradiction to the oath that I have taken, to the people, to the Michigan Constitution, and to the United States Constitution.

In addition, I recognize that the Administrative Procedures Act of 1946 ("APA"), and revised in 1969, is unconstitutional and unenforceable as a law, that any and all rules or guidelines promulgated and approved under this act are unconstitutional, unenforceable, and are repugnant to the Michigan Constitution and the United States Constitution as defined by the United States Supreme Court in *Maybury v. Madison*, 5 U.S. 137 (1803), that the APA, and any and all rules and guidelines promulgated or approved through the use or enforcement of the APA, violate and contradict the ruling of the U.S. Supreme Court, "An unconstitutional act is not law; it confers no rights; it imposes no duties; affords no protection; it creates no office; it is in legal contemplation, as inoperative as though it had never passed." *Norton v. Shelby County*, 118 U.S. 425 (1886).

Furthermore, I recognize that the APA violates the separation of power between the three branches of government by usurping the legislative process as stated within the Michigan Constitution and the United States Constitution, and that Congress failed to apply the *McCulloch* test, which requires a law to both be appropriate and consist[ent] with the letter and spirit of the Constitution, and in doing so violated the express or implied constitutional provision, including the system of dual state-federal sovereignty established by the Constitution, and that Congress failed to follow the rulings in *A.L.A. Schechter Poultry Corp. v. United States*, 295 U.S. 495 (1935), where the U.S. Supreme Court held that "Congress is not permitted to abdicate or to transfer to others the essential legislative functions with which it is thus vested."

I declare that my actions, or lack of, in regards to the enforcement or implementation of the APA, constitutes a violation of my oath to the people, the Michigan Constitution, and the United States Constitution, that my actions, or lack of, that has allowed various directors, commissioners, or any other elected or non-elected official, to use the APA to promulgate rules and guidelines with the force of law that has violated or deprived any legal citizen of the United States of their Constitutional rights, is a violation of law, and that my actions, or lack of, constitutes the following violations under the law; Title 18 sec 241, Title 18 sec 242, MCL 750.545.

I affirm that should I fail or refuse to reaffirm my oath to the people of the State of Michigan, and to the people of the United States, that should I refuse to cease and desist from all activities that violate the social contract, that are repugnant to the Michigan Constitution and the United States Constitution, I understand that I subject myself to being held criminally and civilly liable for my actions, in accordance with the laws of the State of Michigan and the laws of the United States, that among the violations, it shall include, domestic terrorism and treason.

I affirm that my refusal to sign this, Declaration To The People And The Constitution, I am admitting that I am refusing to comply with my oath to the people, to the Michigan Constitution, and the United States Constitution, that I am admitting that I have, and will continue to, violate the social contract, that I am admitting that I have, and will continue to violate the laws of the State of Michigan and of the United States, and that this is grounds for my immediate removal from office, by resignation or by arrest, and that my removal from office does not grant to me any immunity from criminal prosecution or civil prosecution.

I affirm that my decision to sign or not to sign this declaration is my own, that I am under no form of duress, intimidation, coercion, or any other form of persuasion, that I make this decision of my own reconnaissance, that I am of sound mind and body in making this decision, and that I agree to return or make available for pick up by the issuer this document, whether it contains my signature or not, within 5 business days from the date served.
