
#MapMyForest for Sydney Gardens Tree Weekender


MapMyForest is a web app by Planet A Printing which shows you the area of tropical forest being destroyed globally every hour and every day. Instead of giving you a number, MapMyForest shows you how that area looks compared to *your* neighbourhood. You can try the app <u>here</u>.

Below is what it looks like with Sydney Gardens at its center. The inner ring is the hourly rate of deforestation and the outer ring is daily.



It's a lot more than you thought, isn't it! To really feel just how big an area that is, try walking or cycling around or across it.

We have some suggested routes you can try <u>here</u>, as closely as public highways and topography will allow. Walking the diameter of hourly tree loss is 3k from 1 Royal Crescent to the end of Golf Course Rd. A 10k walk will take you around the approximate circumference of hourly deforestation and a 55k cycle ride takes you around the area of daily deforestation.



We've used Google Maps but we're sure that Bath locals will know some routes that Google doesn't.

Reducing, reusing and recycling lessens our contribution to tropical deforestation.
