
1.Place the anti-tumble shelf into the rear of the body.



2.Insert the rear wheel axle through washer, wheel, plastic ring into the body, tighten using a cotter pin.




3. Assemble the two front wheels, insert the plastic ring, wheel and washer, tighten using a cotter pin.



4.Place the four wheel caps into the four wheels.




