## The Fallschirmjäger Battalion 1944-45

## Creating the arguably best units of the Second World War

The Fallschirmjager Infantry Battalion in early WW2 was a traditional paratrooper infantry unit but by the end of May 1941 they were no longer used as paratroopers. The invasion of Greece and particularly Crete caused heavy casualties for the Fallschirmjager, and afterwards they were used as well trained and heavily equipped Infantry.

In mid-1944 They were no longer given paratrooper training and were trained as infantrymen. This training came with a new organisation and the infantry battalion became a very well equipped and well-trained unit. In the later years of the war, most Falschirmjager Divisions were rarely at full fighting strength with most regiments not even having any transport available, usually only 1 per division which was used to perform counter-attacks and offensive operations. By the end of the war most of the Kar98k rifles and MP40 submachine guns were being replaced by the more reliable FG42's and STG44's however not enough was produced to fully replace every weapon, so a variety were usually found spread out between the troops.

The Fallschirmjager Late war Company pack that is produced by Anschluss Wargames is a realistic and excellent value product, with exactly the right number of figures, armed with the correct weapons, to create your company with no unnecessary or 'fantasy' poses.

Below you will find the structure of a full battalion from 1944 -1945. The composition of the forces that make up every sub formation, from company to section are to be found in the 'Stats' sheets. You will see that a Fallschirmjager infantry half section in 1944 and 1945 was a fearsome force, and the weight of firepower in a platoon could easily overwhelm Allied infantry opposition.

You will see that points are provided for formations from battalion to platoon. This is a move away from previous Anschluss doctrine, and will give you a 'direction of travel' for the second edition of the 'War on the Ground' rules, which are slated for late 2024.

In the meantime, we hope that the information here will be of use to you.
