Comparison		
9.5ft Raptor	Pros	It is super lightweight with 31lbs halves making it very easy to carry and transport. It has a pointed nose for carving through waves. It uses two latches to join the halves together making it really quick to get out to your favourite spot.
	Considerations	It is narrower so more maneuverable, so requires reasonable balance when standing and fishing. This can be negated with a pair of cheap and lightweight additions of kayak stabilizers. And it doesn't have a recessed transducer mount.
9.5ft Raider	Pros	It is WIDE so will have great stability especially when sitting or standing. It has built in handles in the front making it easy to pull up on the beach and it weighs less than our other propeller option. It has a recessed transducer mount and 4 flush mounted rod holders.
	Considerations	Wider means less maneuverable, a flatter nose means less carving through waves. While it has lots of hatch storage it doesn't necessarily have a rear cargo to add your own crate/gear, etc
9.8ft Rogue	Pros	It has LOTS of hatches for storage including a big one under the seat. It is slightly narrower so will be more maneuverable and is longer so can take more gear. It has mounting points at the rear to mount a rear based propulsion trolling motor.
	Considerations	It doesn't have recessed transducer mount, and its heavier due to it's length and it has a fixed hull rudder underneath (but this is protected by the kayak spine and could be considered a bonus if you're adding rear propulsion)
9.8ft Rocket	Pros	It is wider so will be more stable, has a big front hatch which can be turned into a livewell and solid forward and aft built in handles for pulling up the beach. Has a rectangular cockpit hatch which is much easier to store a battery than a round hatch if you're adding a trolling motor later. It also includes a recessed trolling transducer mount.
	Considerations	With additional width comes additional weight. It has 2 latches above and three latches underneath to fix the modular halves together.
10ft Radar	Pros	It has a recessed transducer mount and is slightly longer which will provide more speed through the water than shorter kayaks. It has great weight capacity for it's size.
	Considerations	Has a slightly flatter nose, but will only make a marginal difference in waves. Uses a 3 latch system underneath as well as two on top to join the halves. It has only the one cockpit hatch, the forward and aft cargo areas are exposed.
13.8ft Rocket	Pros	It is wider so will be more stable, has a big front hatch which can be turned into a livewell and solid forward and aft built in handles for pulling up the beach. Has a rectangular cockpit hatch which is much easier to store a battery than a round hatch if you're adding a trolling motor later. It also includes a recessed trolling transducer mount.
