Observe the grainline arrows on the templates except for A-3: $\square$

NOTE: In the book, this block is made with 2 fabrics. It was my personal choice to use 4 fabrics.

1. To cut the 4 rectangles with template A-1 instead of template $\mathrm{C}-19$, cut strips on lengthwise grain as wide as A-5 (2"). Then place one edge of A-1 on the edge of the strip. Cut to length and nip the corners. Rotate the square to nip the corners on the second side of the rectangle.

2. When you make the first Square Within a Square unit with pieces cut with the From Marti Michell engineered corners, it is love! Add A-6 corners to opposite sides of A-3 center square. Press toward square. Then add remaining corners and press toward triangles.

3. Join units into horizontal rows and press toward rectangles.
4. Join rows and press toward the rectangles.
