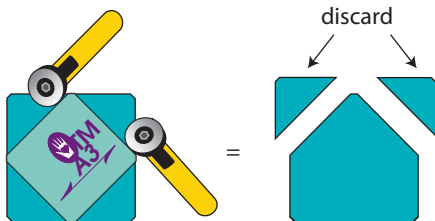

Observe the grainline arrows on the templates when cutting except A-3:

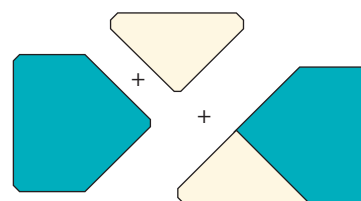


We made a personal choice and modified the block.

- Center A-3 as shown on the A-1 squares and cut away two adjacent corners.

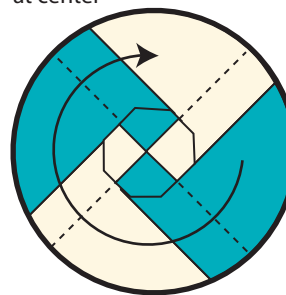


- Join remaining A-4 triangles to modified A-1 pieces for the center row. On the wrong side, swirl press in a clockwise direction; 1 or 2 stitches will pop as you distribute the bulk.



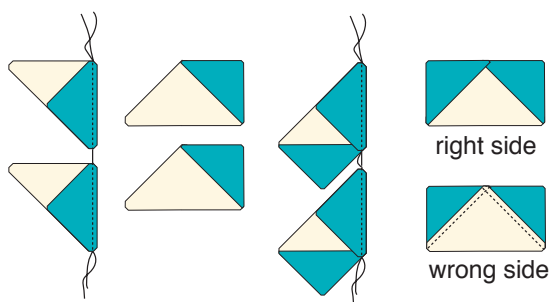
- If you are not modifying the block, the zig-zag seam that joins the halves will be easier to stitch by hand than machine.

closeup where 4 seams meet at center



OR—If you are modifying as indicated on the chart in purple:

- Make 2 Flying Geese units with 4 A-6 and 2 A-4 triangles.



- Join the rows to complete the block.

- Add A-5 squares to each Flying Geese unit. Press toward the squares.
