
Cutting

The big time-saver here is to cut and stack strips for the small D-29 or N-80 triangles. Since you need 6 of one fabric and 18 (3 times 6) of the other, cut strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " wide and 8" long, enough to cut 6 triangles. Cut 3 strips of one color and 1 of the other. Put 1 strip of each color right sides together in the stack—Do not separate those pairs after cutting, they are ready to sew together.

The rest of the cutting is very straightforward. Cut strips as wide as B-12 ($2\frac{1}{2}$ ") and the equivalent of 24"-27". I cut 3 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9". Cut the B-12 and B-13 pieces from the strips.

Making the Block

1. Make the Birds in the Air pieced triangle units as shown below. Join the triangles pairs that were cut right sides together. Press toward the matching (tan) triangles. Continue adding the additional triangles as shown.



- **2.** Join with the B-13 triangles. They should be exactly the same size. Press toward the B-13 pieces.
- **3.** Arrange the pieced units and cut squares in rows as shown in the book and complete as shown.
