Observe grainline arrows on templates when cutting.

1. This block is very straightforward. Use paper patterns or a ruler to cut B, G and E and make the center square. True it up with template B-10.
2. Add triangle B-13 corners to complete the center unit. It should measure $41 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square, including seam allowances.
3. Cut the $\mathrm{N}-80$ triangles with fabrics right sides together. Do not separate; they are ready to sew. Two sets of 2 strips right sides together as wide as N-79 ( $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) and $9^{\prime \prime}$ long are long enough to cut the small triangle pairs and N-79 squares.
4. Complete the block as shown in the book.
