## Pat's Basket (Bomus Bloses)

A Bonus Block in The Farmer's Wife 1930s Sampler Quilt Sew Along based on the book by Laurie Aaron Hird

## Cutting the Background Pieces

1. Cut a background fabric strip $2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ on the lengthwise grain.
2. Cut 1 A- 5 square from strip and then fold remaining strip in half.
3. Cut A-4 triangles and modified A-1 or C-19 rectangles from folded strip. Yield: 2 each.


## Cutting the Basket Fabrics

There are 4 basket fabrics.
Four patch unit-Cut 2 each A-5 squares from 2 different fabrics.
Basket feet-Cut 2 A- 6 triangles with hypotenuse on straight grain from third fabric.
Top of basket-Cut 4 A-6 triangles from fabric 4.


Arrows indicate grainline override. Observe grainline arrows on all other pieces.

## Making the Block

1. Make the four patch center and swirl press seam allowances.
2. Make 2 Flying Geese units with A-4 and A-6 triangles. Press toward the small triangles.
3. Add A-5 background square to one Flying Geese unit. Press toward the square.


Make 1
4. Join the A-6 basket feet to the background rectangles. Press toward the rectangles.

5. Join the units in numbered order. Press after each addition as indicated by arrows.
