## From MARTI MICHELL Perfect Patchwork Templates Conversion Chart



This is a great cut-and-sew block. The big 61E pieces provide a nice space for a fussy-cut motif.

You may want to hand piece the Y seam where 61A and 61C (and 61B and 61D) join to E.

Even though the Deluxe Corner Trimmer does not have the same odd angles as these pieces, I used the straight edge and blunt corner of the  $53\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  angle as shown to mark the dot for dot-to-dot sewing on the wrong side of pieces 61A, B, C and D.

The holes in the From MARTI MICHELL tools for marking dots are sized for water-erasable or similar marking pens.



Because the long edges on the small pieces were cut on straight grain, we made the choice to cut the square corners on the 61E pieces on straight grain.



Assemble as shown in the book, sewing dot-to-dot or dot-to-edge seams, as appropriate.
