


Cutting the Modified S-98b Piece


1. Use template S-98 to measure the strip width and cut a strip about 18" long. Cut 4 S-98b trapezoids as shown:





2. Turn pieces over and use template S-98 to modify the opposite end of the trapezoids. Carefully align the diagonal corner of the fabric with the cut line for S-98b on the template and trim the other end of the piece as shown.





Cutting 69A and 69B (From Marti Michell S-99 and S-100)

- 1. Use S-98 to measure strip width, a scant 1¾". Cut a strip approximately 15" long from both fabrics. With right sides together, cut 4 pairs of S-100 triangles and 4 pairs of S-99 squares.
- **2.** From another strip of "light" fabric, cut 8 additional S-100 triangles and 1 more S-99 square.

Making the Block

1. Join the triangle pairs. Press toward the dark.



2. Add the light triangles to each end of the trapezoids.



- **3.** Make the center nine patch, pressing toward the dark.
- **4.** Complete assembly as shown in the book.
