## Mirror Image Alert!

1. Cut strips scant $11 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ long. Join lengthwise and true up one end. Cut 2 rectangles the length of S-98y and create a pair of mirror image parallelograms as shown below.

Cut 2 right side up


Trim excess and nip point

2. From background fabric cut 3 M-76 triangles and 2 S-98y rectangles.
3. Cut 10 pairs of S-100 triangles with fabrics right sides together. Do not separate the triangle pairs. Chain piece 6 pairs into half-square triangle units. Separate the remaining pairs. You will have 2 extra triangles of the "basket feet" fabric.

4. Assemble the block as shown in the book.
