




Please note: If you choose to use the Farmer's Wife paper templates, the pattern piece labeled 15A is not the correct size. The paper foundation piecing pattern does appear to be the correct size. This block is designed on a 5×5 grid, so piece 15A should be cut with triangle S-100.

1. Cut 10 pairs of S-100 triangles with fabrics right sides together. Do not separate the triangle pairs. Chain piece 10 pairs into half-square triangle units. Press toward the dark fabric. Don't forget to cut 5 more "blue" S-100 triangles.



2. Sew N-80 triangles onto the tip of the L-68 triangle. Confirm size, then cut away the excess fabric underneath.



Cut the remaining pieces. After joining the half-square triangles into rows, press seam allowances on the rows in alternate directions – one row up, the next down, etc. Complete the block as shown in the book.
