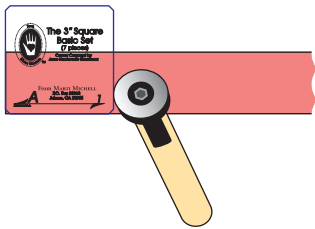
Observe grainline arrows on templates when cutting, except N-81: 

Mirror Image Alert!

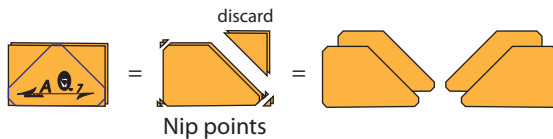
The way the pieced corner units are shown in the book requires 2 each of 2 mirror image pieced units, and we are writing instructions for that. However, if you make 4 alike, just rotate 2 until the 50E squares are on the outside corner.

Square A-1 — We chose to use a third fabric for the center square.

Square A-1 modified — Cut a strip 2" wide and at least 15" long. Fold in half to 2" x 7½" or 8" long. Align one edge of the A-1 template and cut rectangles to length.



LCR-b modified — Cut strip 1¼" wide and at least 6" long. Fold in half and cut 4 LCR-b strips. With the strips still right sides together, modify by aligning A-7 triangle template on the cut strips and trim off one corner.

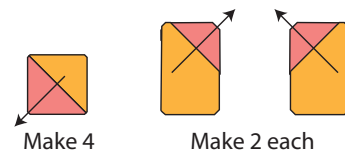


LCR-a — Cut 4 squares.

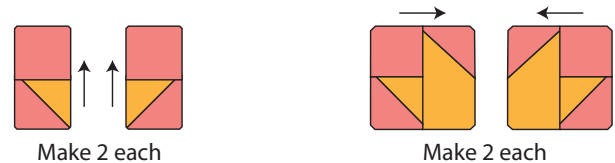
N-81 — With 2 fabrics right sides together, cut 4 pairs of N-81 with the legs on straight grain. Cut 4 more of the background color.

Making Lady

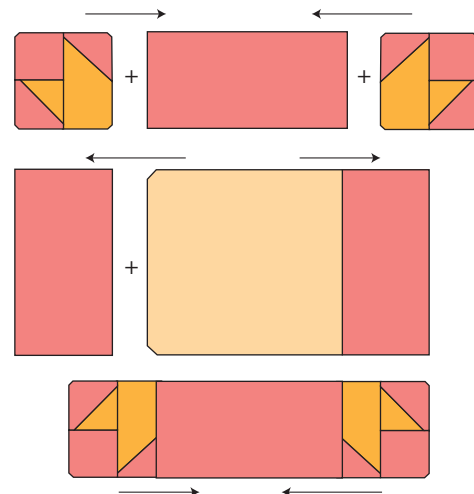
1. Assemble the sub-units as shown in the book. Make 4 each. Press as indicated by arrows:



2. Make the 4 corner units. Press as follows:



3. Arrange and join units into 3 rows as shown in the book. Press the small pieced corner units as shown.



4. Join the rows to complete the block. Press the final seams toward the center.
