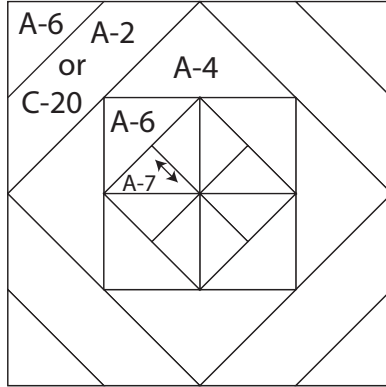
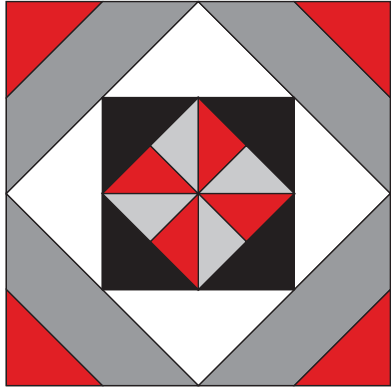


27 Dinah (Or alternate block, Dorothy)

Since we chose not to make Dinah, Dorothy is our substitute. For personal use in conjunction with the Farmer's Wife 1930s Sew Along and these **From MARTI MICHELL** Tools: Perfect Patchwork Template Sets A #8251. Optional: Set C, #8253.



Cutting the Pieces From the Center Pinwheel Out

Refer to previous PDFs for the Marti Way to measure and cut strips for A-7 pinwheel fabrics. Observe grainline overrides with A-7  on both fabrics for center Pinwheel.

A-7—Cut 4 each of 2 Pinwheel fabrics.



With fabrics right sides together, cut 2 strips 6" x width of template. Cut in half and stack.

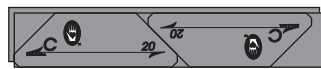
A-6—Cut 4 from a 2" x 6" strip.



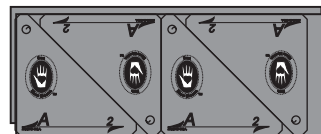
A-4—Cut 4 from 2: 2" x 6" strips.



C-20—Cut 4 from 2 strips cut 9" by width of template.



OR A-2—Cut 4 from 2: 3½" x 9" strips.



A-6—Cut 4 from 1: 2" x 6" strip for corners of block.

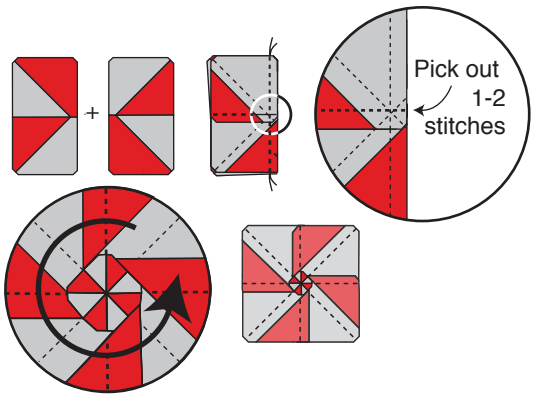


Making the Dorothy block

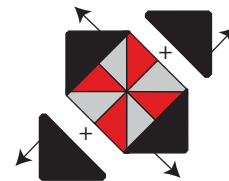
1. Chain-piece A-7 triangle pair. Press toward the dark.
2. Join pairs as shown and press to the light fabric.



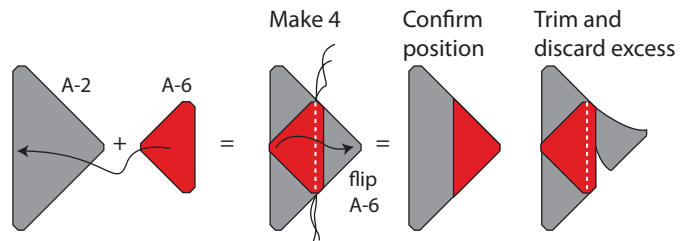
Then join to complete the pinwheel. Swirl press the center.



3. Add 4 A-6 triangles to the pinwheel. Add opposite sides first and press toward A-6 pieces. Add final two A-6 triangles.



4. In the same manner add 4 A-4 triangles to center unit.
5. Make corner units by joining C-20 pieces and A-6 corner triangles. Press toward A-6. **OR** position A-6 and A-2 triangles right sides together as shown below so that all three nubbed corners of A-6 are aligned with the edges of the A-2 triangle. Stitch as shown. Flip A-6 triangle to cover seam. Confirm that the outside corners of the two pieces align and then cut away the excess A-2 fabric. Press toward A-6.



6. Join corner units to center unit to complete the block. Press toward corners.
