Check the Sizes


In our version of the book, the pattern measurements for the center strip and square in Carrie appear to be too narrow. Since the "bow ties" finish at $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square, the center piece needs to be 1" finished for a 6" finished size block. That is the adjustment we made.


Cutting

The classic "Bow Tie" block can be entirely ruler cut because we are substituting squares for 21D and 21A. However, if you own Sets N and Q, why not use exact size squares? We have also chosen to add a little dimension to the bow ties by using folded triangles to create the knots.


Making the Block

- 1. Fold the 1" squares in half diagonally, right sides out, and press.
- **2.** Align a small folded triangle on the corner of a Q-c background square and machine baste in the seam allowance. Repeat for all 8 squares.






Swirl press the centers:



4. Arrange the bow tie units with the center strips and center square. Join into rows.



5. Join the rows to complete the block.
