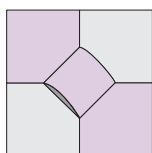


Bonus Block

Dimensional Bow Tie

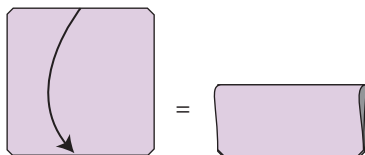

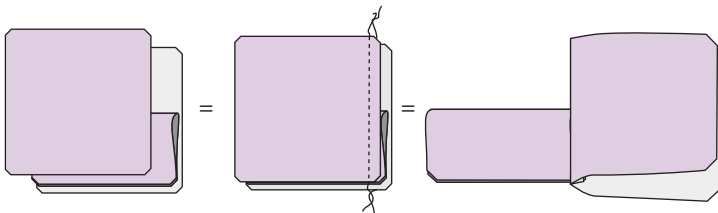


This fun block is made with five squares of equal size cut from two fabrics. Look at the block diagram to determine fabric placement.

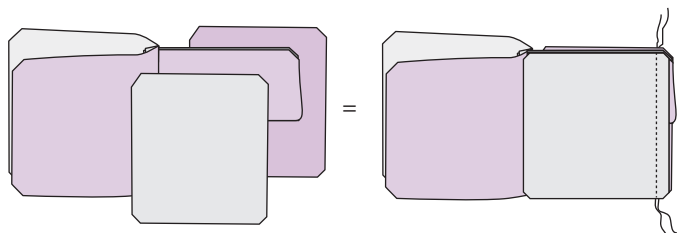
1-2. Fold the “knot” square in half, wrong sides together.



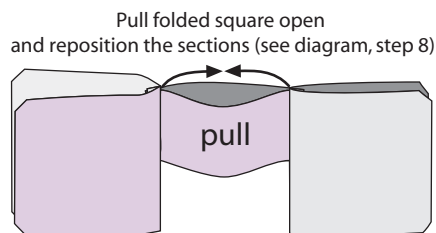
3-4. Sandwich it between two contrasting squares, right sides together, as shown. Sew one side, and open out.



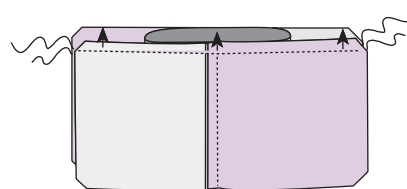
5-6. Rotate and sandwich the folded square between the remaining two squares so that opposite fabrics show on top.



7. Sew down the opposite side and open the pairs away from the folded square.



8. Bring the two pairs right sides together, matching seam lines and adjusting raw edges of folded square to match raw edges of pairs. Pin one half of this section from the center to the edge; be sure the folded square will not be caught when sewing. Sew from the center out. Repeat on the other half.



Shameless Plug!

You can make Dimensional Bow Ties in 4 sizes with Sets A and C and 4 more sizes with Sets B and D. And if you like making Dimensional Bow Tie, you will love Dimensional Spools on page 29 of Volume 2 of the *Encyclopedia of Patchwork Blocks*. The same template sets are used to make 3 sizes each.
