Override grainline arrows on all pieces.

Cutting Aunt Gladys

Cut 20 A-7 with legs on straight grain. Cut 2 strips 1 1/16" wide (length of A-7 leg) and 15" long. With strips right sides together, cut 10 pairs of triangles.

Cut 1 square A-5.

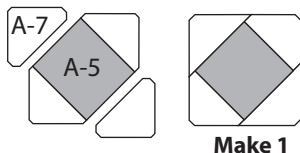
Cut 4 A-6 corner triangles with legs on straight grain. Cut from 1 strip 2" x 6 1/2" and pin together for easy identification.

Cut 8 A-6 with hypotenuse on straight grain from the same fabric. Cut 2 strips approx. 1 1/16" by 9 1/2" and stack.

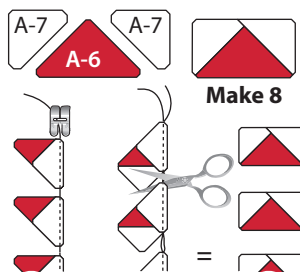
Cut 4 A-4 triangles from a strip approximately 2" x 12".

Making the Block

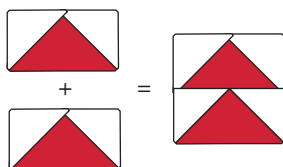
1. Make the Square in a Square unit. Press toward the triangles.



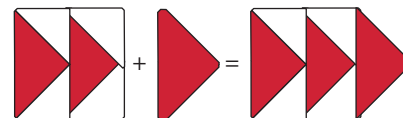
2. Make 8 Flying geese units. Press toward the small triangles.



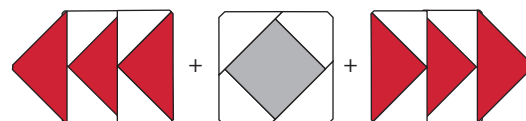
3. Join the Flying Geese units into 4 pairs. Press toward the "goose" on top. Make 4.



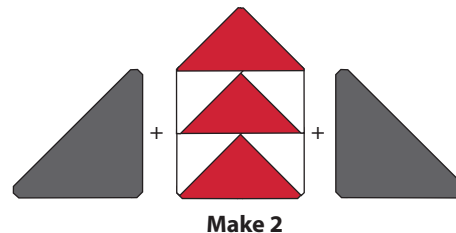
4. Add corner triangles to pairs of Flying Geese. Press toward the corner triangles. Make 4.



5. Make 1 center strip. Press the seams open.



6. Make 2 side units. Press toward the triangles.



7. Join to complete the block. Press seams open or to the side.
