Pieces for this block are cut with templates S99, S98a, S100a, and S-100.

Make a fabric key:

Fussy-cut the center square with template S99.

## Make 4 Corner Units

1. Cut 1 white strip and 1 red strip as wide as S 99 and $11^{\prime \prime}$ long. With right sides together, cut 8 pairs of S100 triangles. Do not separate, but sew together on the long edge to make 8 half-square triangles. Press toward the dark fabric.

2. Cut 1 dark gray strip as wide as S 99 and $15^{\prime \prime}$ long. Fold in half and cut 8 S 99 squares.
3. Join 8 half-square triangle units from step 1 with 8 squares from step 2. Join all in this orientation unless you have used a directional fabric.


Press toward square S99, regardless of color.
4. Join pairs of units from step 3. Press open.


## Cut and Make 4 Center Side Units

1. Use this cutting trick to eliminate 1 seam in each unit. Cut 4 S-98a red pieces. Turn template 98 over as shown, aligning the line for the cut size with the fabric piece. Then trim off one corner as shown.

2. Cut strips $11 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ wide for piece 100a. Cut 1 white strip $8^{\prime \prime}$ long. Cut 8 100a triangles with the hypotenuse on straight grain.


Cut red strip $11 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ by $4^{\prime \prime}$ long. Cut 4 100a triangles.
3. Join 4 pairs of red and white pieces on one leg. Position with white on top and lead under the needle with the square corner, as shown. Press toward dark fabric.

4. Add remaining white S-100a triangles to the side of the altered red 98a pieces. Press toward the red fabric.

5. Join the units made in steps 3 and 4. Make 4. Press seams in either direction or open.

## Complete the Block

Cut 1 contrasting S99 square for the block center; ours was fussy cut. Join into 3 horizontal rows. Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams open.
