

Cutting

Cut the small triangles—Cut 1 strip each of gold and pink fabrics and 2 strips of blue fabric, 2" wide by 7" long. Stack the gold and pink strips right sides together and place the blue strips on top. Cut 4 stacks of A-6 triangles. Nip the corners as you go.

Remove the blue triangles from each stack, but do not separate the gold and pink triangles. They are ready to sew.




Cut a strip of pink 2" x 9". Cut 4 A-5 squares.

Cut a strip of gold 2" x 11". Cut 4 A-4 triangles.




Making the Block


1. Join the pairs of gold and pink triangles to make 4 half-square triangle units. Press toward the dark fabric.



2. Join the HSTs to make the center section. Press the seams in the same direction as the HSTs and swirl press the center.



2. Make 4 Flying Geese units with the blue A-6 and gold A-4 triangles. Press toward the small triangles.



- **3.** Arrange the units and the 4 pink A-5 squares as shown in the book and assemble rows. Press rows 1 and 3 toward the squares. Press the center seam rows open.
- **4.** Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams open.
