


Observe grainline arrows on templates when cutting.

Cutting

Cut 2 strips of fabric 1 (light green) 2" wide by 16" long. Stack and fold the strips in half. Cut 1 stack of 4 pieces using each of the Set A templates listed in the chart.



Cut a strip of fabric 2 (dark green) 2" by 14" long. Fold the strip and cut 4 pairs of A-6 triangles.




Cut a strip of fabric 3 (yellow) 1¼" by 8" long. Fold the strip and cut 2 pairs of A-7 triangles.




Making the Block


1. With green on top and point leading into needle, join pairs of A-7 triangles as shown. Press toward the darker fabric.




2. Join A-6 triangles to the units made in step 1. Press toward the large triangles.



3. Join the units made in step 2 to make the center section. Press as shown.



2. Make 4 Flying Geese units with the dark green A-6 and light green A-4 triangles. Press toward the small triangles.



- **3.** Arrange the units and the light green A-5 squares as shown in the book and assemble rows. Press the seams open.
- **4.** Join the rows to complete the block. Press the seams open.
