


Observe grainline arrows on templates when cutting.

Cutting & Making the Corner Four Patches

1. Cut strips 11/4" wide by 6" long: 1 each of fabrics 1 (yellow) and 2 (red) and 2 strips of fabric 3 (blue). Sew pairs of strips together as shown below. Press seam allowances toward fabric 3 (blue). Cut both strip sets into $4 1\frac{1}{4}$ wide strips.




2. Arrange pairs of segments as shown. Join to make four patches. Swirl press seam allowances.




Cutting & Making the Center Nine Patch


1. Cut 2 fabric 2 (red) strips 1¹/₂" x 5" and 1 fabric 3 (blue) strip 1¹/₂" x 7". Join as shown below, pressing toward fabric 2 (red). Sub-cut into 3 $1\frac{1}{2}$ " strip sets and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric 3 (blue) square.



- 2. Remove the stitching to release and discard 1 fabric 2 (red) square from 1 strip. (See diagram below.)
- 3. Add the fabric 3 (blue) square as shown to make a new segment. (See diagram below.)




4. Arrange the 2 original strip sets with the unit made in step 3, as shown, and join. Press seam allowances open.



Cutting and Making the Side Units

Cut and make 4 Flying Geese units with 8 blue A-6 and 4 gold A-4 triangles. Press toward the small triangles.



Complete the Block

- 1. Arrange the units as shown in the book and assemble rows. Press Rows 1 and 3 toward the four-patch units. Press the center row toward the nine-patch.
- 2. Join the rows to complete the block. Press seams toward rows 1 and 3.



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
