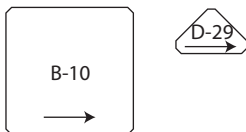

Override grainline arrows on templates B-10 and D-29:




Cutting

From background fabric (light green) cut:
1—B-10 square 4—B-13 triangles 16—D-29 triangles

From contrasting fabric (dark green) cut:
4—B-14 triangles 4—strips 1" x 9" on lengthwise grain

Making the Pieced Units

 We have chosen a simplified technique to create the same visual result as the block shown in the book. Instead of mirror-image parallelograms with a "Y" seam, we are adding strips the width of the parallelograms to D-29 triangles and trimming away excess to create the shapes needed. You'll love working on a rotating mat.

1. Place a D-29 triangle on a 1" wide strip, right sides together, aligning one leg with the edge of the strip. Sew in place. Stitch 7 more D-29 triangles to the strip in the same way. Press toward the strip (diagram 1, below).

2. Trim as shown:

a) Align a small ruler with the other leg of the D-29 triangle and cut across the strip to separate the units (diagram 2, below).

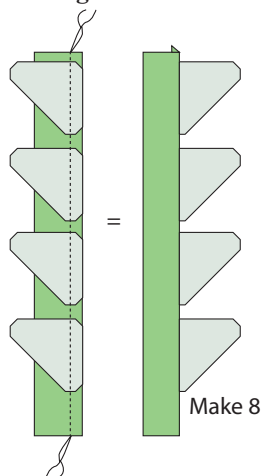
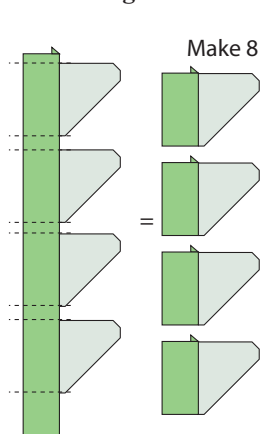

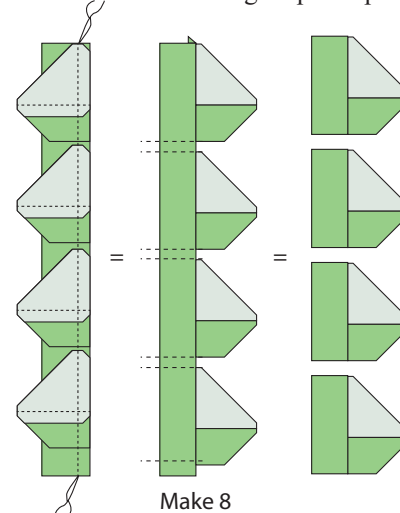


b) Place B-14 on a sewn unit. Align as shown and trim off the corner of the strip. Repeat for all sewn units.

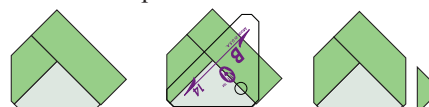


3. Add the trimmed units to another strip, as shown below. Press toward the strip. Separate the units and trim again as shown.

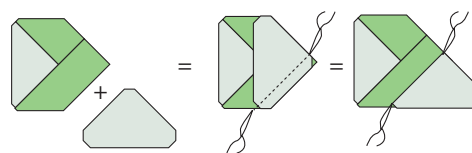
a) Align a small ruler with the bottom edge of the first strip in the sewn unit. Cut across the long strip to separate the units.



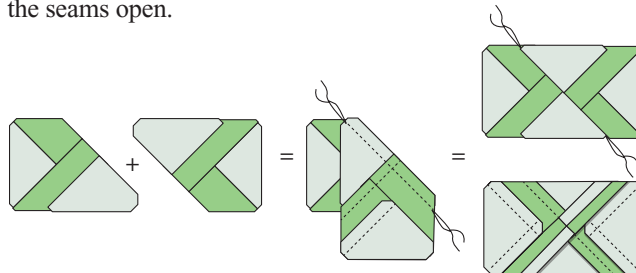
b) Place B-14 on a sewn unit, aligning as shown. Trim off the end of the second strip.



4. Add another D-29 triangle to each trimmed unit from step 3, as shown. Press toward the D-29 triangle.



5. Join pairs of units made in step 4 to make 4 pieced units. Press the seams open.



6. Complete the block as shown in the book.
