






Strip Piecing Center Units

1. Cut 1 pink and 2 yellow strips a scant inch wide and 9½" long on the lengthwise grain.



2. Join the strips so they alternate colors as shown. Press toward the center strip. Working on a small cutting mat, cut 4 D-28 squares from the pieced strips. Rotate the mat to nip the corners.




3. Cut 4 scant 1" squares of both yellow and pink fabrics and one from the purple fabric. Make a nine-patch unit from the squares. Press rows 1 and 3 toward the pink. Press row 2 toward the purple. When joining the rows, press toward rows 1 and 3.

Cutting the Remaining Pieces


1. Make 4 half-square triangle units. Cut 1 pink and 1 purple strip 2" wide by 6" long. Put right sides together and cut 4 pairs of B-14 triangles, as shown.



Join the triangle pairs on the long side and press toward the pink triangles.



- 2. Cut 4 D-28 squares from the purple fabric.
- 3. Cut 2 strips of pink fabric 1½" x 11" or choose a fourth fabric for the outside edge as we did. Stack the strips. Cut 8 B-14 triangles and 4 D-29 triangles, as shown, Observe the grainline arrows on the templates.



Completing the Block

- 1. Join into units as shown in the book. After adding the outside triangles to the pieced half-square triangle units, press toward the triangles on the outside.
- **2.** Join units to complete the block. Press all other seams open as you join units.
