

Making the Starry Path Block


Finished Size: Starry Path is a multi-size template. Cut 12", 9" or 6" blocks. Cut with **From Marti Michell** Product #8586














Making the Block

In the templates there are small holes for marking match points or dots. We particularly recommend that you might want to use them on the first several blocks.


Stack your fabric pieces into the triangle shape you will eventually make.




1. Join the shortest sides of **A** and **B**. Place them right sides together matching the square corner and bottom edges. Press seam open.




2. Turn **A/B** over onto **C**, matching angle at top. Match dots marked B and C and nubbed corners. Press toward piece C.




3. Turn A/B/C onto **D**. Sew with A/B/C on top, from narrow end to wide end. Match center seam of A/B to appropriate dot (12", etc.) on D. Match angles at end of pieces. Top of D extends just slightly beyond A. Press toward A/B/C unit.




4. Join 2 pieced triangles to make a half block. Press toward the pieceD with the unseamed edge. Match square corners that will be in the center of the block.



5. Join 2 halves to complete the block. Swirl press center to press each half toward the piece **D** with the unseamed edge.
