
Tessellating Windmill



- **Step 1.** Stack all fabrics for each row. Cut squares 1¹/₂" larger than desired finished size.
- Step 2. Use our new tool to cut 4 Windmill blades—on grain! Cut and rotate 4 times for each row.
- **Step 3.** Lay out stacks for all rows in one vertical row. This quilt has 5 rows (6 rows when the "built in" border pieces are added).
- Step 4. Follow instructions to play "Leap Frog."
- **Step 5.** Add border pieces to the stacks. Add to the top of the left hand stacks and bottom of the right hand stacks.
- **Step 6.** Chain piece each stack separately to make horizontal rows.
- Step 7. Join the rows to complete the quilt top.







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8 Finished Block Sizes from 2" square to 9" square
