What happened is that I was using the machine just fine, I logged off and gave another user access through the guest account. The dialog came up said that it needed to restart the machine so that it would present a safari only interface. Clicked OK and this is where I am at.

The machine rebooted into the recovery mode (Mac OS X Utilities) and I have tried everything, and I cannot get back to my normal login screen

I've tried to go into safe mode I still get the recovery mode.

I've tried to reset the PRAM, it asks me for my filevault password I give it and I still get the recovery mode

I've tried single-user mode and I still get the recovery mode.

Any suggestion would be welcome.

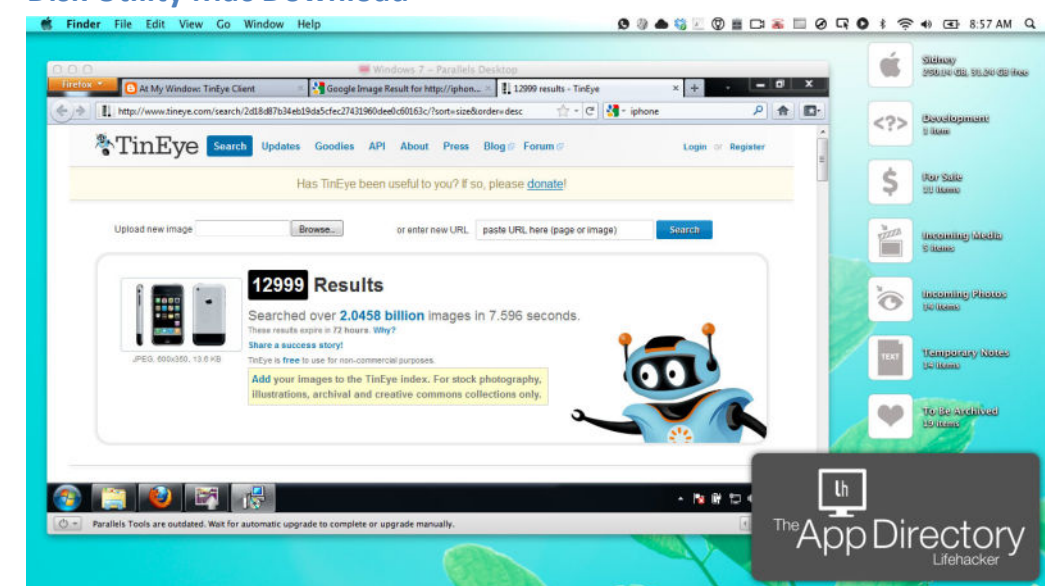
