Read all assembly and care instructions carefully before using this product. Save these instructions for future reference.

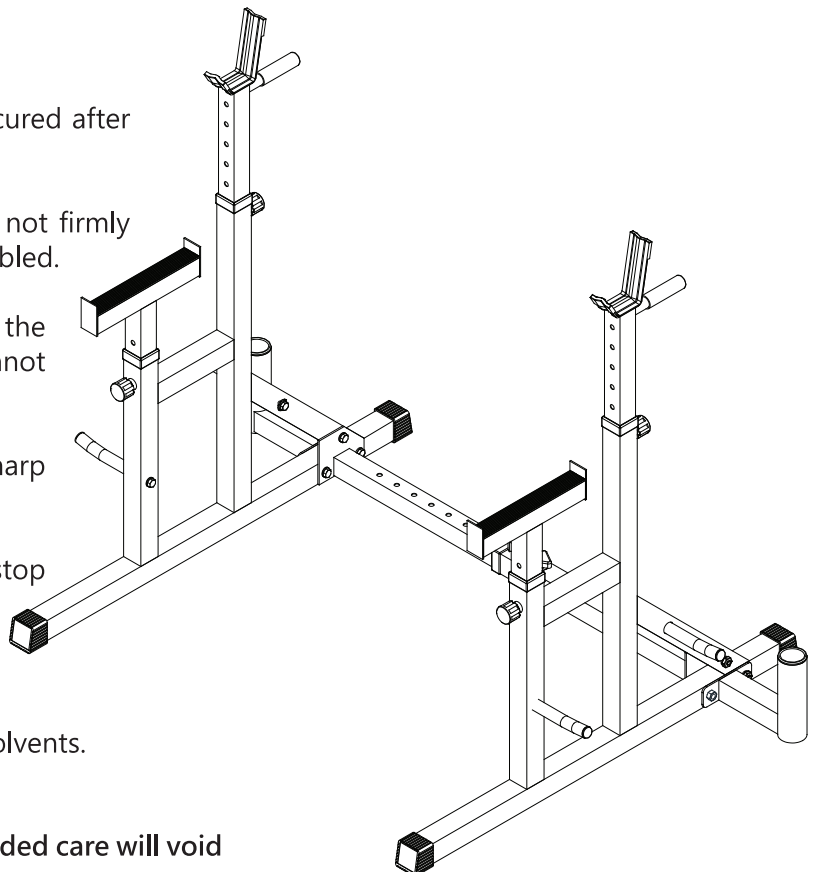
- Select a smooth, level surface to place the barbell rack's parts.
- Assemble components on a soft, clean surface to avoid scratching and/or damaging the finish.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Ensure all parts are accounted for before disposing of packaging.
- This package contains small parts. Keep away from children & pets at all times. Adult assembly required. Screws left after assembly should be kept out of reach of children.
- Consult your physician before starting your exercise program. For your own safety, do not begin any exercise program without proper instruction.
- If the user experiences dizziness, nausea, chest pain, or other abnormal symptoms stop the workout and seek immediate help

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Under normal use, STOZM Barbell Rack will last for years. It is, however, important to follow basic care tips to prolong the life of your Barbell Rack.

USE & CARE

- ▶ Please do not exceed the weight limit of this item.
- ▶ Do not stand on or use any part of this item as a step ladder.
- ▶ Keep clear of cables and all moving parts when the machine is in use.
- ▶ Inspect and tighten all parts before using this item.
- ▶ Reconfirm that all bolts, screws and knobs are secured after every 30 days.
- ▶ Fasten screws loosely during initial assembly. Do not firmly tighten the screws until the item is completely assembled.
- ▶ Safety: To increase safety and stability, please use the corresponding wrench to tighten the nuts. You cannot tighten the nuts by hand only.
- ▶ Be aware that some parts are heavy and have sharp edges.
- ▶ If any parts are missing, broken, damaged or worn, stop using this product until repairs are made and/or factory replacement parts are installed.
- ▶ The equipment can be cleaned using a damp cloth and mild non-abrasive detergent. Do not use solvents.



Any modification or failure to follow the recommended care will void the product warranty.

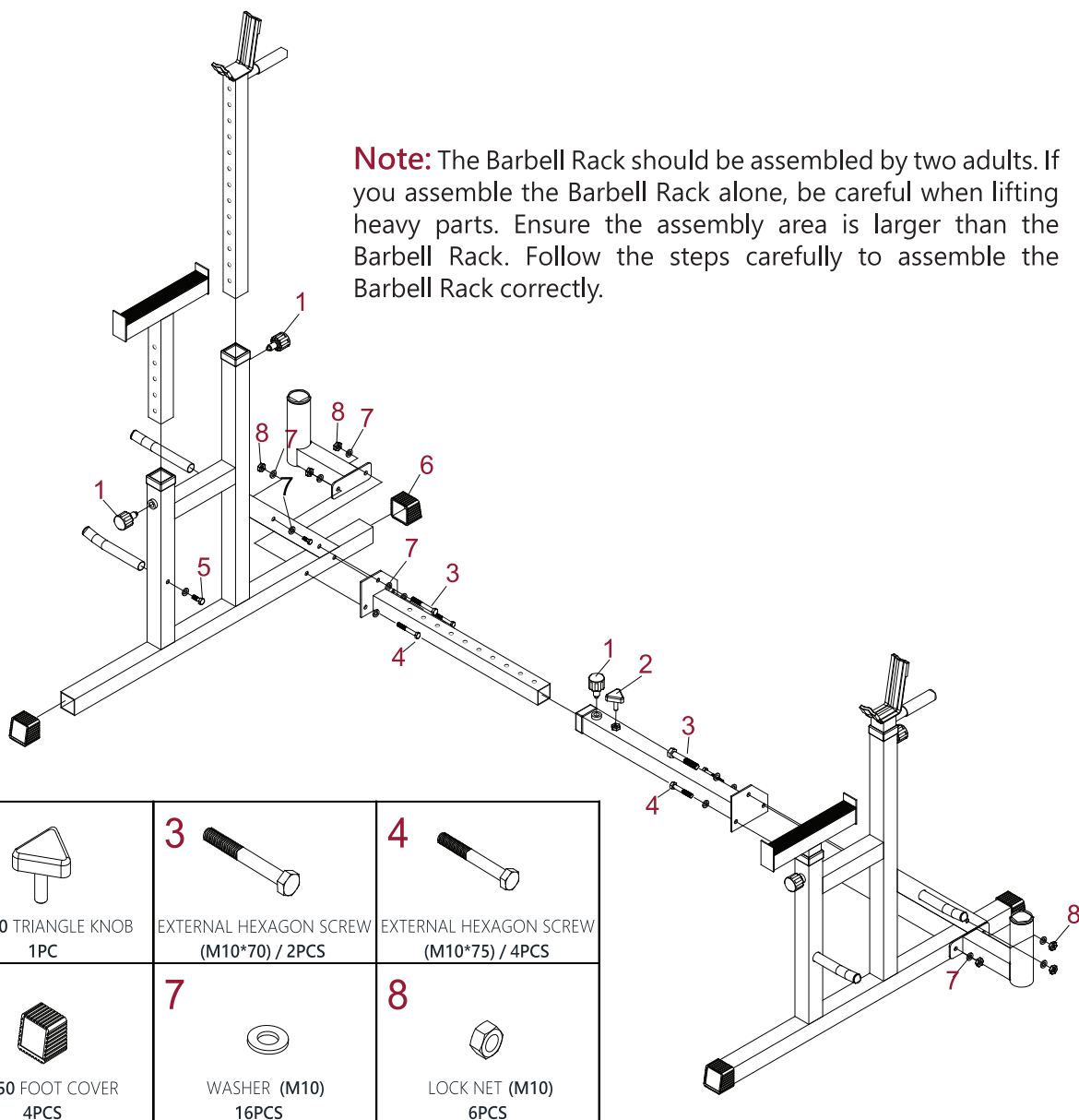
