Vintage Notes

Morello cherries, fresh raspberries, and white flowers finish dry with plenty of zip on the palate. The 2021 vintage fills the glass with a rosé quartz hue that looks refreshing and inviting. This Rosé can be enjoyed all year long and compliments a bevy of food dishes such as your favorite BBQ dishes, grilled fish, pasta with white sauce, and summer salads.

Tasting Notes by Devin Kennedy – Michael Lavelle Wines Sommelier

Appearance: Iridescent, rose quartz hue, medium viscosity with moderate forming tears.

Aroma: Highly aromatic with lush strawberry bramble, fresh raspberries and cherries for fruit alongside notes of white lilies.

Palate: The beginning of the palate reveals bright fresh raspberries and strawberries from the farmers market and watermelon rind. On the mid palate the fruit continues to sing alongside herbal notes of white pepper and young white tea leaves that extend to a long crisp dry finish that begs you for another sip.
