




How to Assemble Your Cadillac

What Comes in the Box

- A. Cadillac Frame
- **B.** (4) Traveling Pipes (6" for transit only)
- C1. (2) Vertical Pipes and (2) C2. Vertical Pipes attached to (1) Push Through Bar
- D1. Canopy
 - D2. (2) Trapeze Slider Tension Knobs
 - D3. (4) 3-way Flange
- E. Trapeze Assembly including...
 - 1. Trapeze Bar
 - 2. Trapeze springs
 - 3. (2) Double Hooks
 - 4. (4) Quicklinks
 - 5. (1) 27" Trapeze Strap
- **F.** Roll Down Bar [including (2) Roll Down Springs and (4) Double Hooks]
- G. (2) Leg Springs
 - (2) 9" Foot Loops and 4 Double Hooks
- H. (2) Arm Springs [4 Double Hooks]
- I. (3) Safety Chains
 - (7) Stow Chain
 - (6) Quicklinks
 - (3) Swivel Hooks
- J. (2) Wooden Handles
- K. (2) 20" Foot Strap
 - 2 Double Hooks
- L. Kuna Board (Spread Eagle)
- $\mathbf{M.}$ (2) Sheepskin Hanging Loops
- N. 90" Webbing Strap
- O. Allen Key
- **P.** (2) 5/16" Eye Bolts (side)
- **Q.** (2) 3/8" Eye Bolts (rear)
- R. (2) Trapeze Slider Tension Knobs







Remove Allen key insert/bolt that is inside the Cadillac before installing.

STEP 1 - Remove Contents from Box


Place the box long side down. Use the scissors carefully to cut ties. Two Packed bundles should be in the box with everything listed on the "What Comes in the Box"






STEP 2 - Remove the Traveling Pipes

Use the Allen key to unscrew the traveling pipes from the Cadillac frame (Figure A). Next, use the Allen key to unscrew hex screws in the traveling pipes from the Cadillac frame (Figure B). Be sure to hold the travel pipes while unscrewing, so they don't fall through. Then remove the traveling pipes (Figure C).


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



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
STEP 3 - Place the Vertical Pipes and Canopy on Cadillac

Locate the Allen key and 4 vertical pipes. Loosen the screws and insert the 4 vertical pipes into he flanges on the Cadillac frame (**See Figure D**). Tighten the screws until the vertical pipes are firmly secure (**See Figure E**). Carefully place the canopy on the top of the 4 vertical pipes (**See Figure F**). Carefully tighten the screws until the canopy is firmly secure on top of the vertical pipes (**See Figure G**).












STEP 4 - Prep for Use

Prior to using, make sure all springs are in place to your liking and are properly attached.


STEP 5 - How to Position your Trapeze Set

To adjust the Trapeze set, twist the 2 black knobs until the top crossbar is loose (Figure H). Then slide the Trapeze set to the position of your liking (Figure I). Tighten the black knobs until the cross bar is firmly in place (Figure J).
