

## DOMESTIC MACHINE QUILTING

## SUPPLIES LIST

- Sewing Machine Feed dogs need to be able to be lowered
- Walking Foot or Dual Feed
- Darning Foot to do free-motion quilting you must have this foot
- 90/14 Sharp Needles
- Pins
- Snips
- Medium Scissors
- Seam Ripper
- Wonder Clips
- Mechanical Pencil or #2 Pencil
- Thread(s) to match your project
- Marking Tools of your choice chalk, Bohin, washout marker, air dissolve marker, Frixion pen
- 1" Safety Pins (50 100 recommended)

## FABRIC REQUITZEMENTS

- (1) Fabric Panel (Approximately 24" x 42")
- Batting (Approximately 34" x 52")
- Backing (Approximately 34" x 52")

## CLASS PREPARATIONS

- 1. From Muslin Cut:
  - A. 16" x 21" rectangle
  - B. 20" x 25" rectangle
- 2. Tape down the 16"  $\times$  21" rectangle on a hard surface. With a pigma pen, starting 1/2" away from the 16" edge, mark a vertical line from top to bottom. Continue marking lines every 2" across the top.
- 3. Starting from the top (21") edge, mark a horizontal line every 1 1/2".
- 4. Make a quilt sandwich by laying down your 20" x 25" muslin rectangle, then the batting, and then the marked rectangle. Spray baste or safety pin the layers together.
- 5. Gather your supplies and we will see you in class!
