

# Domestic Machine *Quilting* Class

## Class Preparation

### From Muslin Cut:

- (1) 16" x 21" rectangle
- (1) 20" x 25" rectangle

**1.** Tape down the 16" x 21" rectangle on a hard surface. With a pigma pen, starting 1/2" away from the 16" edge, mark a vertical line from top to bottom. Continue marking lines every 2" across the top.

**2.** Starting from the top (21") edge, mark a line every 1 1/2".

**3.** Make a quilt sandwich by laying down your 20" x 25" muslin rectangle, then the batting, and then the marked rectangle. Spray baste or safety pin the layers together.

**4.** Gather your supplies and we will see you in class!

## Supplies Needed

- Walking Foot or Dual Feed
- Darning Foot - to do free-motion quilting you must have this foot for your machine
- 90/14 Sharp Needles
- 1" Safety Pins (50 - 100 recommended)
- (1) Fabric Panel (Approx. 24" x 42")
- Batting and backing (both must be approx. 34" x 52")
