TUCKER UNIVERSITY Corner Beam

The Corner Beam adds even more iunique options to the quilt designs. The combinations and the twists and turns makes it look as if the quilter had to work with lots of odd shaped pieces when in fact they did not. The consturction of a Sliver unit advances the use of the Corner Beam and once again makes precise piecing look hard, when it is easy.

Fabric Preparation

Block 1: Corner Beam 4" finished unit

Fabric A: Cut (4) 5" squares

Fabric B: Cut (1) 5" strip x WOF

Block 2: Silver 4" finished units

Fabric A: Cut (4) 5-1/2" squares Fabric B: Use the remainder of the Fabric B

strip from the Corner Beams Fabric C: Cut (4) 5-1/2" squares
