

# TUCKER UNIVERSITY *Square Squared*

The Square Squared unit can be found within blocks as well as sashing. Since this unit is often used to connect other units, the points are extremely valuable for the design to work without interruption. Use Deb Tucker's method of creating Square Squared units to not waste fabric. It's a win-win situation.

## Fabric Preparation

**Block 1: Square Squared 4" finished units**

Fabric A: Cut (4) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric B: Cut (8) 3-1/4" squares

**Block 2: Fussy Cut Square 4" finished unit**

A fussy cut square of at least 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"  
(this will be trimmed with precision in class)

Fabric B: Cut (2) 3-1/4" Squares

**Block 3: Little Houses 4" finished units**

Fabric A: Cut (4) 4-3/4 squares

Fabric B: Cut (8) 2-3/4 squares

## Supplies Needed

- Square Squared ruler and Quilter's Magic Wand
- Invisigrip (optional)
- Best Press or light starch (optional)

## Sewing Basket Supplies

- Sewing machine (*including power cord and foot pedal!*)
- Rotary cutter and various rulers
- Pins
- Sewing machine needles
- Seam ripper
- Thread
- Tape measure
- Marking pencil
- Wonder Clips
- Snips and medium scissors
