Fabric A: Cut (4) 5" squares
Fabric B: Cut (1) 5" strip x WOF
Fabric C: Cut (4) 2-3/4" squares

## Unit 5:

Fabric A: Cut (4) 5" squares
Fabric B: Use remainder from Unit 4-5 strip
Fabric C: Use (4) 2-3/4" squares
